The Mountain

Standing at 19,340 feet, Kilimanjaro is the tallest mountain in Africa and one of the world's "Seven Continental Summits." This dormant volcano is considered the world's tallest freestanding mountain, rising 15,100 feet from base to summit.



The Team

Marking his 14th summit of Kilimanjaro, Peter Whittaker will lead a small group to the "Roof of Africa" this fall.

No crampons, ropes or heavy expedition loads are required - just passion and a powerful desire to reach the top. The Climb

While not technically difficult, Kilimanjaro's high elevation provides a hearty challenge, making it a worthy introduction to mountaineering and high altitude exploration. The seven-day Machame route allows ample time for acclimation and is well known for its breathtaking views.



The Safari

Kilimanjaro towers over the plains of Arusha, Tanzania, offering visitors the added experience of an authentic African safari. Post climb, you will embark on a three-day trek to Tanzania's Serengeti National Park and Ngorongoro Crater, to witness an incredible spectacle of wildlife.

Production Value

To capture the unforgettable adventure from start to finish, climbers will be joined by a professional still & video photographer. High quality images will be available to team members and a 25-minute video will be produced to document the once-in-a-lifetime experience.
